An international movement was birthed when small groups of Holy Spirit-inspired and activated Christians experienced explosive growth. The CRC has helped people from all walks of life not just to find Jesus, but also to find His call on their life. The CRC International Missions Bible College (IMBC) is a further extension of that heartbeat.

The CRC International Missions Bible College (IMBC) is one of the official training and college arms of the CRC Churches International movement. We are committed to training up believers and the leaders of our next generation. Since the inception in Adelaide Australia of the first CRC Bible College in 1959, the College has continued to grow and change.

A number of training Colleges have subsequently been launched from the CRC Churches International. One of these is the CRC International Missions Bible College (IMBC), which offers graduate training to various nations in English, French and Swahili.

STRONGLY PRACTICAL

In partnership with local churches, CRC International Missions Bible College (IMBC) equips students for effective ministry by practical application of theological studies in an environment which promotes both fruitfulness in ministry, and is also personally fulfilling.

BIBLE BASED

We believe that the Bible, as originally written and correctly interpreted in its historical context, is the authoritative word of God, informing all of our theological beliefs and ministry practices. Our intention is that students become thoroughly grounded in the knowledge, truth and principles of the Bible, and its application.

LOCAL CHURCH COLLABORATION

Study at CRC International Missions Bible College (IMBC) requires every student to be actively involved in at least one ministry area within their local church. All students are required to work in cooperation with their home church or in a church endorsed by their Pastor.

What We Offer

Christian Ministry and Theology

- CRC743INT Diploma of Christian Ministry and Theology

These Graduate awards can be offered in pastoral ministry in Christian Ministry and Theology. This suite of Christian Ministry and Theology subjects form the base requirements for pastoral and platform ministry for anyone wishing to serve in ministry within the CRC Churches International.



Organisational Philosophy

Our philosophy is to provide an authentic, legitimate Bible College to individuals and to local churches in an easily accessible way.

Our role at CRC International Missions Bible College (IMBC) is to endorse the efforts of traditional Bible Colleges.

We are deeply committed to the concept of training people within their own local churches and areas, and to the provision of excellent teaching material and study options for Christians everywhere.

We treat the entire local church environment as part of our "leaning process". The worship of the local church, its witness, its fellowship, its teaching, its ministry – are all reckoned to be part of the process of equipping men and women to serve Christ.

Our function is to add a theological and academic resource, working with local churches to exercise the practical training for ministry.

Educational Philosophy

Underlying the way in which the materials are presented, and the assessment methods are used, is an educational philosophy based upon the following principles:

- 1. Christian education must stand upon a strong theological foundation ("sound doctrine" 1 Timothy 1:10; 4:13; 2 Timothy 4:3; 2 Peter 2:1-3; Jeremiah 6:16; 1 Corinthians 3:10-13; etc.)
- 2. Students must know God, not just to learn about him.
- 3. The goal is not just to impart knowledge, but rather to teach principles of sound interpretation, using the resource materials that are available.
- 4. The Bible is a self-revelation of God, who discloses himself and his glory in scripture.
- 5. Since the glory of God is mirrored in scripture, we believe that God particularly reveals himself through the teaching and/or preaching of His Word. All teaching must aim to gain an intelligent, believing response to the Word of God, leading to a life of obedience to the will of God, and of conformity to the character of Christ.
- 6. We practice "open-book" assessments, plus typically multiple-choice exams, as well as exams. The combination of "open-book", multiple-choice assessment and exams aims to instruct the student in analytical thinking and develop an ability to discern shades of doctrinal meaning.
- 7. We look to the local church to provide "field" experience, through each student's active participation in the worship, work, and witness of the church.

CRC742INT Certificate in Christian Ministry and Theology.

This course is for those who desire to live a life following the example of Jesus Christ. It is empowering, Holy Spirit led, highly practical and Biblically based training, and is the CRC Churches' mission and foundation. Set upon the foundation of fostering greater intimacy with God, from where all ministry expression flows, it prepares students for active Christian service. The Certificate runs over one year.

Prerequisites:

- A high school academic requirement or equivalent;
- Recommendation of a CRC Churches International pastor;
- Recommendation from your Pentecostal church pastor;
- One-year minimum active service within the local Pentecostal church;
- Demonstrate some sound knowledge of the Word of God.

The format and subjects are as per the following:

- CRCTHE303 CHRISTOLOGY, NEW CREATION REALITIES, NEW TESTAMENT CHURCH - Identify a range of information within a theological theme or issue
- CRCTHE304 HOLY SPIRIT & DEMONOLOGY Identify new theological insights
- CRCMIN301 AUTHORITY & AUTHENTICITY OF THE BIBLE Identify theological knowledge in relationship to the Christian way of life
- CRCMIN302 BIBLE PROPHECY & THE RETURN OF JESUS -Communicate theology in everyday language
- CRCTHE402 HERMENEUTICS & PUBLIC SPEAKING Interpret theological Data
- CRCTHE403 FAITH, HEALING, EVANGELISM Identify a range of information within a theological theme or issue

The Theology subjects are designed to produce a sound understanding and depth of knowledge, and require a greater level of research in the Word of God to strengthen students' Christian life and ability to serve the Lord Jesus Christ.CRC International Missions Bible College is open to those who have an active role in a local Pentecostal church and have an endorsement from a CRC Churches International pastor.

CRC743INT Diploma of Christian Ministry and Theology

For those who are continuing from Certificate, or who enter into the course with advanced standing, the Diploma of Christian Ministry and Theology continues and extends the students' skills in learning, enhancing their faith in and understanding of God's Word and will for their ministry and at a corporate level.

The course includes a broad range of challenging, faith building, and Biblically-based studies relevant for personal, pastoral, church and community life. Students will learn to apply Biblical principles to their daily lives, and gain the ability to explain and share those Christian truths with others.

This course is designed to train effective Christian Ministry in His Church locally and abroad, bringing an ability to effectively communicate the Gospel. Ascension-gifted individuals and church leaders will be equipped in a range of Christian ministry activities relevant to the local Church, Christian organisation and the workplace.

Prerequisites:

- Completed a Certificate in Christian Ministry and Theology or similar
- Recommendation of a CRC Churches International pastor Recommendation from your Pentecostal pastor
- Two years minimum active service within the local Pentecostal church
- Demonstrate some sound knowledge of the Word of God Active in pastoral or platform ministry.

The format and subjects are as per the following:

- CRCTHE501 CHURCH HISTORY Analyse and interpret theological beliefs in the light of current thinking
- CRCTHE502 SYSTEMATIC THEOLOGY & BIBLE CUSTOMS -Analyse and interpret theological data
- CRCTHE503 APOLOGETICS, BIBLICAL TRUTHS and BIBLICAL EXTREMES - Research and analyse information within a theological theme or issue
- CRCTHE504 CHRISTIAN ETHICS Identify new theological information
- CRCMIN501 CHURCH PLANTING Relate theological ideas to the Christian way of life
- CRCMIN502 SPECIAL SERVICES, HOMILETICS & COMMUNICATION Communicate theology in a clear form
- CRCLEG001 CHURCH MANAGEMENT Manage legal and ethical compliance
- CRCMGT003 LEADERSHIP PRINCIPLES Lead the work team
- CRCPAS001 PASTORAL COUNSELLING & INTRODUCTION TO PSYCHOLOGY - Provide coaching and motivation

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Full-Time Students

A student who is enrolled into the program and intends to complete one subject per month, is considered a full-time student.

Course Emphasis

A student may be able to specialise in a specific field of study such as Counselling, Missions, Chaplaincy or other while satisfying a particular award level.

Theology Units

We recommend that students read the material three times,

- 1. First as a "scan read" to become familiar with the material,
- 2. The second time to study the material in depth,
- 3. The third time to complete the open book assessments as supplied with the subject.

Resources

The flexibility of the delivery modes makes it possible for the students to learn in their preferred place of learning.

Resources may include and are not limited to the following options:

- 1. Prepared notes
- 2. Recommended texts
- 3. Experienced mentors
- 4. Email
- 5. Seminars

Student Records

Student records are maintained in a secure Student Management System Database. No student can receive a graduation without work for each subject being marked compliant (competent), and stored with the CRC International Missions Bible College (IMBC) Trainer. Sample work from selected students will be requested and each student, along with their trainer, will need to sign a course successfully completion form statement that will be stored in the IMBC database. Also stored in the IMBC is a copy of each student's awards, their student application and their student photo. Students may contact CRC International Missions Bible College (IMBC) to request information about the records.

Church Affiliation

All students must be active members within the life of a local church. This means attending their regular services, and other appropriate church programs. Students must make themselves available for service above and beyond what is required of an ordinary member of the local church. This service may count towards RPL credit for the practical experience units Title.

Graduation

Student graduation ceremonies can held after the CRC International Missions Bible College (IMBC) have received all the required forms showing the student have successfully completed and these have be verified and entered all data into the IMBC database. After the CRC International Missions Bible College (IMBC) have completed these steps they will produce the Awards and give permission for the graduation ceremony to he held. After receiving permission for the graduation ceremony to help, a date will be nominated by the local bible college and preparation for the ceremony will be made by the local bible college.
